De-Coding Horror Info-Graphic

Learning Goal:

In using applications such as Adobe Photoshop Elements or Canva, students will individually produce an infographic that summarizes key ideas presented in either the video clips shown in class and/or the reading provided. The goal is for students to show critical understanding of horror cinema through an original media text creation.

Success Criteria:

Ideally, the success criteria should be co-constructed in class with students.

Key factors for success include but are not limited to:

- 1. 3 5 key summary points that define the social, cultural and political relevance of horror cinema based on the video clips and/or reading.
- 2. A balanced flow in design between text and images.
- 3. Images / graphic layout must reinforce meaning and speak to the horror genre.
